



#### Dates - Distance

The Individual Time Trial will take place on Tuesday 29 May at 09.00

Distance: Four (4) rounds of 4.000 km plus 1,400 km at the beginning of the race = Total 17,400 km

Time limit for the competition will be estabilished by the UCI regulations

The Prize Ceremony will take place ten (10) minutes after the arrival of the last racer.

The Road Race will take place on Saturday 2 June at 09.00

Distance: Fourteen (14) rounds of 7.300 km plus 2,100 km at the beginning of the race = Total 104,300 km

Time limit for the competition will be estabilished by the UCI regulations

The Prize Ceremony will take place twenty (20) minutes after the arrival of the last racer.

## Roads and Training

The Roads will be closed to traffic only during the competitions. Roads will remain open during training. Race will take place on Saturday 2 June at 09.00

#### COMPETITION REGULATIONS

#### Regulations

The cycling competitions will take place in accordance with the rules of the Fédération Internationale de Cyclisme (UCI), unless specific exceptions are made by the present regulations and the GSSE technical regulations.

# Participation - Conditions for the organization of competitions and events

Each participating country may enter a maximum of five (5) cyclists, but only four (4) will be admitted for each road race and time trial competition, with exception of the organizing country, who is allowed to enter eight (8) athletes in both events. The four cyclists to be scored for the team competition of the organizing country are to be declared before the race.

Registration by name must be received by the Organizing Committee by the 7 May 2001 at latest.

The cycling competitions will be held only if, on the date of receipt of entry by number, at least ten (10) cyclists have been entered from three (3) countries.

#### Team Classification

For team classification, the times performed by the three best-placed cyclists of each country will be added up. The team performing the best (lowest) total time will be declared the winner. The countries having less than three (3) cyclists in the individual classification will not be considered for team classification.

## Circuit Inspection - Technical Meeting - Starting Order List

The official inspection of the racing course will take place on Monday 28 May at 13.00. The race, which will be started at the Start/Finish line in San Marino, and the race will be introduced by the UCI technical delegate.

The Technical Meeting will take place immediately after the official road inspection on Monday 28 May at about 14.00 in the Centro Studi in Fonte dell'Ovo. On the occasion of this meeting, which will be chaired by the UCI Technical Delegate, the particularities of the course and the competition regulations will be explained. The starting order will be set by draw during the Technical Meeting. In front of each racer there will be an accompanying motorcycle.

#### Individual Time Trial

The Individual Time trial will take place on Tuesday 29 at 9 o'clock with the start of the first cyclist of the first group. For the other group, the total number of concur rents must be taken in to account. A bulletin of the Race Jury, at the end of the Technical Meeting, will inform about the starting order list for each racer to the team officials. The interval between each racer will be of one (1) minute.

The individual participation by name must be confirmed from 11 till 12.30 of Monday 28 for the Time Trial event with national licenses and equipment.

Riders must be ready for the start 20 minutes before the race for the undersigning of the start sheet and in order to permit commissaries bicycle verification.

#### Road Race

The individual participation by name must be confirmed from 10 till 11 of Friday 1 June with national licenses and equipment.

Riders must be ready for the start 20 minutes before the race for the undersigning of the start sheet.

#### Refreshments

The athletes are allowed to receive beverages between the 7<sup>th</sup> round and the 11<sup>th</sup> lap. For safety reasons, it is strictly forbidden to hand over beverages from the accompanying vehicles.

No refreshments are allowed during the individual time trial.

# Competitor numbers - Starting Order List

The drawing of lots will be carried out in the Technical Meeting; the starting order decided will provide a one (1) minute time distance between riders. The team officials will receive the competition number for each cyclist entered in the respective event. The following numbers (white ground with black numbers) will be used:

n.1 Frame number

n.2 Back number

The numbers must not be cut, folded or changed in any way. Helmets must be worn during all competitions and training events

#### Technical support

For each participating country, an accompanying vehicle will be available for the road race. Each team is responsible on their own for the material and technical support. The organiser provides two neutral vehicles with the necessary technical equipment and technically qualified staff, available for all teams.

For the time trial, an accompanying motorcycle is assigned to every rider.

Maintenance positions can be placed in the designated zones. A material storage box will be assigned to each country for both competitions at the Start/Finish area.

#### Info-Service

All necessary information will be transmitted by wireless sets and by loud speakers in English, French and Italian. The accompanying vehicles are connected via radio-tour.

#### Anti-doping Control

Anti-doping controls will be carried out immediately after the races. Competitors called for doping controls will be accompanied to the medical office, situated near the locker-room on the football ground of Fonte dell'Ovo (close to the Tennis Centre).

#### Prize Awarding

The prize awarding ceremonies will take place after each event.

In accordance with the GSSE regulations, the following prizes will be awarded:

- Gold Medal to the athletes ranking first in each individual event and in the team event.
- Silver Medal to the athletes ranking second in each individual event and in the team event.
- Bronze Medal to the athletes ranking third in each individual event and in the team event.
